## This funding will be used to

Implement a whole school approach to the teaching of reading and writing

- 90% of students will achieve National Minimum Standard or above in all areas of NAPLAN
- 90% of students reach or exceed age equivalency for reading
- All students achieve a "C" standard in English and Mathematics

## Our initiatives include

- Building staff data literacy proficiency to improve teaching practices of reading and writing.
- Provide focused and explicit teaching of reading and writing skills.
- Monitor early phase literacy and numeracy, including the schedule of Early Start Assessments, opportunities for professional conversations regarding student progress and strategies for intervention.
- Consult with support staff from the Centre for Learning and Wellbeing to develop proficiency in delivering a structured synthetic phonics program.
- Staff attending professional development courses/workshops to further their professional knowledge and practice around the teaching of literacy and numeracy.
- Strengthen teacher judgements of assessment by implementing rigorous internal and external moderation processes.

- Purchasing of resources, online and physical, to support the implementation of a structured synthetic phonics program through PLD..... **\$1,833**
